



The City of Riverside's Housing Rehabilitation Program helps low income households rehabilitate their homes. Interest-free loans and a limited number of grants are available to help finance housing repairs for income eligible homeowners.

# HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAM LOAN AND GRANTS



## **REHABILITATION LOANS**

Interest-free loans up to \$40,000 to correct health and safety hazards, code violations and general improvements. Loans are deferred for a 30-year term for qualified buyers. The loan becomes due and payable if the property transfers or no longer remains owner occupied. A Deed of Trust is used to secure the loan (as a lien on the property).



#### SINGLE FAMILY GRANTS

**Grants up to \$5,000** are available to income-eligible applicants who own a single-family residence, to correct health and safety hazards or minor code violations.



### **MOBILE HOME GRANTS**

**Grants up to \$10,000** are available to mobile home owners to correct health and safety hazards.
